The following is the 1st Amendment just as it appears in the Bill of Rights: <u>Congress shall make no law respecting</u> an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

It is obvious in my opinion that the 1st Amendment is written in *Plain English*, using common words and punctuation; it is very clear and to the point. What was in a sense humorous but sad at the same time, is that when I looked up the amendment on the internet hundreds of commentaries and "opinion pieces" popped up on the screen! You could spend days - weeks – perhaps even months, sifting through thousands of pages of commentary written about 45 common - everyday language words! Why are there so many interpretations of what is stated in one simple sentence? Is it perhaps to confuse people and to distort the simple meaning to get people to see and believe that it says things that simply are not there? The power of suggestion is another way to put it. Once again, the amendment is only 45 words, so let's pick it apart and analyze what it actually says... at face value. I am going to use definitions that are commonly familiar to me from memory, so if I deviate from your favorite dictionary, forgive me. I am doing it this way to show what the average person (such as myself) would ascertain from actually reading the original words of the amendment... something that is apparently not done very often, especially by young people today. Let us begin... I will display the actual words in **Bold Type**, while displaying my thoughts and comments in *italics*, and my opinions or my interpretations of meanings Underlined.

Congress... (Who or what is Congress?) This is the legislative branch of our government... the ones who write our laws... supposedly according to the will of the people they represent. Congress is comprised of the House of Representatives and the Senate...shall make no law (how many laws?) None - Zero Na-Da... respecting (what does this mean?) It means pertaining to... concerning... relative to... applying to... an establishment of religion (what's this?) a group of people who worship their God (or Gods) according to their beliefs... a church, synagogue, or temple..., or prohibiting (what's this mean?) It means to prevent, to stop, to interfere with... the free exercise thereof; (what does it mean to exercise religion?) It means to practice... to carry out the requirements of... to obey the tenets of a particular religion or system of beliefs... or abridging (What's this?) To diminish or lessen... to cut off... the freedom of speech, (What is this?) unrestrained or unrestricted ability to voice your opinion... (Note: this does not pertain to slander...) or of the press; (Who is the press?) At the time this was written the press i.e. newspapers and other publications were the "Media" of the time to relay news and events. This would include all common means of mass communication in our time... or the right (What is a right?) Something you are legally entitled to... of the people peaceably to assemble, (Peaceably) calmly - without violence - under control... (Assemble) To gather or meet as a group... and to Petition Ask or request... the Government for a redress correction or adjustment... of grievances. Feeling of being wronged or treated unfairly...

Now that we have exposed the 1st Amendment in its nakedness, without further opinions or commentary, what does it say to you at face value? Does what it says, deviate from what you have been taught in High School or College? This is an important question, especially if you happen to be a Christian in the United States of America. The reason being, this amendment is used daily against the very people and groups it was written to protect! American Citizens, especially the young are being taught a pack of lies and distortions about not only the Bill of Rights, but also the entire Constitution, not to mention the foundations of our country! Sorry to say, most Christians deserve the majority of the blame for this propagation of ignorance! (More on this later) Most people, if you were to ask them to explain the 1st Amendment would immediately respond with, "Separation of Church and State!" When asked to explain the meaning of "Separation of Church and State", the majority will go on to explain that the Government and anyone connected to it cannot at any time display

anything that indicates their religion (especially if they are Christian)... nor can anyone attending a Government sponsored event do likewise. They would go on to tell you that religion cannot influence the Government in any way, and that the "Founding Fathers" of our nation sought to keep government and religion separate... hence Separation of Church and State. Is all of that true? At the beginning of this study, I provided two renditions of the 1st Amendment, one in raw form, "as it actually appears in the Bill of Rights," and the other Amplified with the common definitions of key words included. As is plain to see, the first part does in fact deal with religion; however, it very simply states that Congress shall make no law pertaining to religion or the practicing of religion. Nothing is written or implied concerning people working for the government, not being allowed to make their beliefs known, nor does it state or imply that Religion must have nothing to do with Government. Therefore, from where did this concept of, "Separation of Church and State" come. I think it best for you to read it for yourself. Read the letter written to Thomas Jefferson from Deacons of a Church in Danbury Ct. and then read, and pay particular attention to Jefferson's reply to them.
